My thanks go to all of you who supported the summer work meet at Tyn Lon - lots of jobs done and the cottage is looking great.

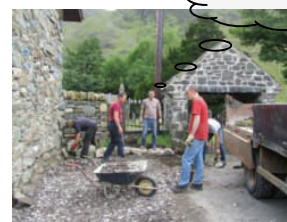

## River Severn Canoe Meet 20th July 7PM

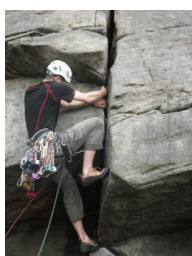
